The day will begin at 9:30 am on Wednesday, May 21 with a tour of the <u>Museum of the</u> <u>Rockies</u> (MOR). Renowned worldwide, MOR is hailed as a premier destination for those seeking an immersive experience in the cultural and natural history of the Northern Rocky Mountain region. Its remarkable collection of dinosaur fossils, including the fully-mounted *Montana's T. rex* skeleton, stands as a testament to its status as a leading institution in paleontological research and exhibition.

Following the visit to the Museum of the Rockies, attendees will head to the local <u>Bozeman Hot Springs</u>, located just west of Bozeman for a soak in the more than 12 indoor and outdoor pools available. A small pool enjoyed only by a few in the late 1800's, has evolved into a destination for area residents and tourists seeking a unique Montana experience with friends and family.

Guests will end the day downtown at the <u>Sky Shed</u> located at the Kimpton Armory Hotel downtown in Bozeman (just blocks from the Emerson conference venue). This rooftop bar offers amazing views of the surrounding Gallatin Valley from the highest building in town!
